CODE OF RESPONSIBILITY

Members please be aware that there are inherit risks in surfing activities that common sense and personal awareness can reduce. Observe the Girls Surfriders Code of Responsibility for a great surfing session. Entering and leaving the water be careful of shore dumpers, possible rips, rocks and other surfers. Watch for items that may be floating in the water.
Know your ability: Be in control of your board and your body. If you feel that the conditions are beyond your comfort zone, don't be compelled to enter the water, ask yourself: "Am I going to enjoy this surf?" **Be Alert:** Watch out for other surfers, loose boards, shallow water, slippery rocks, anyone in difficulty and don't knowingly drop in. Check that your board and leg rope are in good order and protect yourself from the sun and the cold.
